Duties Include: Report to and remain at the designated

beach to which they are deployed for the day unless directed to relief at another beach. Erect the shelter/tents at the beginning of the shift . Keep a detailed register for children received. provide children with refreshments and blankets if necessary. Inform the Law Enforcement of any medical needs, shortages in food, blankets or bedding or any overwhelming anxieties. Must cook three meals a day for the children and ensure that they have sufficient bedding and clothing which has to be kept clean and washed.

Escorting children when they need to use ablution facilities.
Special Conditions attached to the Post: Required to work 8 hour shifts on the beaches or 12 hour shifts at the overnight Facility for 24 hour coverage. Required to work 6 days a

week. Wear the uniform provided while on duty

Service Unit for Seasonal Pool Guides with Appropriate level of education, Minimum 1 month relevant experience, and preferably Minimum 3 months relevant experience.
Duties Include: Controlling the crowd within the confines of the Swimming Pool. Preventing the public from bringing glass utensils into the swimming pool and to remove any glass found within the confines of the swimming pool. Report missing or damaged equipment, facilities, signage or a shortage of bins to the Pool Supervisor. Assist with keeping the pool surrounds litter free and advising the public not to litter. Care for separated children until they are reunited with their parents or guardians. Advise members of the public and ensure that they comply with the acceptable

code of dress and conduct. Alert the Pool Supervisor to any emergency situation. Dealing with public complaints or enquiries.
